A Ready-to-Use Solution for VET Schools Early Detection. Real Support. Better Futures.

Goal

1

To identify and eliminate the risk factors that make students, especially those from vulnerable backgrounds, drop out of school

Who participated

- 115 participants at Baseline Study
- 362 students from 7 VET schools in the Assessment Tool development phase
- 25 teachers from 5 VET schools focused on the development of the Assessment Tool
- 47 active users of the Moodle Platform
- 8 VET schools and 84 VET teachers involved in the piloting phase of the Intervention Mechanism
- 205 students evaluated with the TESTED questionnaires to assess the risk of dropping out
- 34 students benefited from support as a part of the intervention strategy.
- 11 involved stakeholders

Ethics

Informed consent was obtained from all participants. We have ensured that all data has been collected and analyzed with maximum confidentiality and anonymity.



4 Key project information

- The TeSTED Erasmus+ project, co-funded by the European Union, developed a complete help system- an Intervention mechanism to identify vulnerable VET students early and support their retention in school through personalized strategies.
- This initiative brought together Europe: experts, teachers, students, parents, and interested stakeholders.
- Over 36 months (2022- 2025), six partner organisations from Austria, Bulgaria, Germany, Greece, and Romania joined forces and delivered real change in the VET system.

5 Our Achievements

We researched the most common risk factors that push students out of school.

We developed educational resources to support teachers and students.

We piloted a new "In-Campus Office" safetynet mechanism in real schools

We reached hundreds of teachers, dozens of schools, and key policy stakeholders across Europe. We built and scientifically validated early-detection tools, socioeconomic and psychometric assessment tools.

We trained VET teachers and counsellors via a free multilingual online platform.

We gave intensive, tailored support to 34 highly vulnerable students.

The result?

A proven, ready-to-use model that any VET school in Europe can adopt tomorrow – for free.



6 What We Set Out to Achieve

- Build reliable instruments to spot students at risk because of socioeconomic or psychological difficulties.
- Equip VET teachers and staff with the knowledge and skills to use the tools and support students effectively.
- Test the complete TeSTED system (screening → personalised support → progress tracking) in real VET schools.
- Ensure the TeSTED model continues and grows long after the project ends.






7 How We Made It Happen


1. Reliable Early-Detection Tools

 We conducted 22 in-depth interviews and 94 questionnaires with teachers and students across 4 countries, then pre-tested the instruments with 362 students

Delivered


- ABC-Based Functional Analysis model available in all partner languages.
- In-Campus Office Guide offers step-by-step guidance for establishing and running a dedicated student support office within educational institutions, available in all partner languages.
- Anonymous TeSTED Cases Library, a multi-stakeholder database (students, teachers, and parents) that highlights best practices and informs future intervention strategies for diverse dropout scenarios.
- Reporting Tool-Case Recording Mechanism
- Complete VET Dropout Prevention Toolkit (OER) available in all partner languages.
- Student guide "Your Support Circle" mapping national help services available in all partner languages.
- -Ready-to-use intervention templates available in all partner languages.





4. Real-World Piloting of the Full TeSTED System

We ran the complete cycle – screening → In-Campus Office support
 → tracking – in 8 VET schools.

8 What's happening right now (2025 and beyond)

The model is now part of the European VET Association (EVBB) network.

Several schools outside the original partnership are adopting the full system (Greece, Bulgaria, Romania)

Official national accreditation for the TeSTED training program was granted in Romania by Order of the Ministry of National Education No. 3671 on 13.11.2025.


Planned expansion to the lower secondary (gymnasium) level to catch dropouts even earlier.

10 Conclusion – A Ready-to-Use Solution for Europe



- TeSTED has proven that early detection combined with systematic, school-level support dramatically reduces dropout risk.
- 100 % success in the most difficult cases.
- More than 100 VET professionals have already been trained and are using the system
- Everything is free, multilingual, and permanently online.
